Port of Melbourne Traffic Survey 2009

Port of Melbourne Corporation (PoMC) commissions annual surveys to measure traffic movement into and out of the Port of Melbourne.

Selected findings from a 2009 survey are:

- Truck numbers at Webb Dock in the 2009 survey were the same as the 2008 survey
- Truck journeys are becoming more efficient as, on average, each truck is carrying more containers. Across the port, the average number of TEUs* per truck has increased from 1.12 in 2008 to 1.16 in 2009, or a 3.75% increase in utilisation
- Webb Dock truck movements over 24 hours (2151 observations) are comprised of 53% non-container trucks, 36% container trucks, and 10% car carriers
- At Webb Dock, truck movements are concentrated between 7am and 4pm
- Of all vehicle types at Webb Dock, car carrier and low loader operations are more consistent over the 24 hour day, with lower peaks during the day and some activity overnight

*A TEU (Twenty foot Equivalent Units) is a standard 20 foot container
