PORT OF MELBOURNE

Overview

At the hub of a logistics network that extends across south-eastern Australia, the Port of Melbourne is arguably Australia's most important supply chain interface.

The Port of Melbourne is Australia's largest container and general cargo port, handling around 36% of the nation's container trade. There are more than 3500 commercial ship calls each year, giving access to all major trading regions.

It is an important trading gateway, handling over \$90 million in exports on average every day.

The 2007-08 financial year was the seventeenth year of positive container trade growth. And the port has continued to set the pace for Australian container ports by handling 2.25 million TEU in a 12-month period and ranking in the top 50 container ports globally.

Port of Melbourne Corporation (PoMC) has an ongoing commitment to providing high quality facilities and services, facilitating private sector investment in the port and ensuring efficient access to the port by linking with, and working to improve, the broader freight and logistics infrastructure and services.

In support of this commitment, PoMC has produced this customer handbook to provide our customers and stakeholders with a guide to the facilities and services available at the Port of Melbourne, Australia's port of choice.

Facts and figures

As a significant and strategic asset of the state of Victoria, Port of Melbourne provides a range of benefits to the state economy through the facilitation and support of trade related industries.

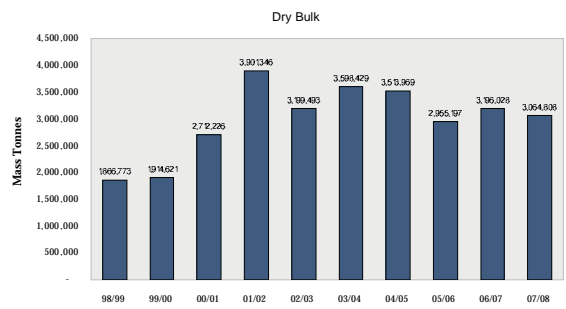
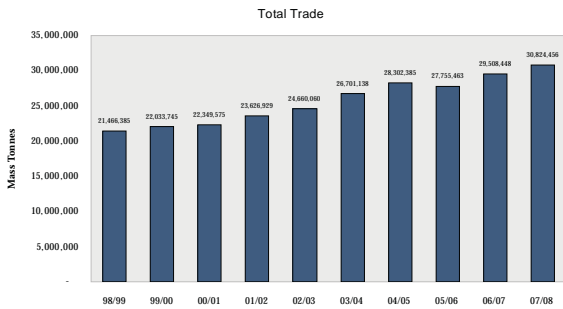
A summary of these benefits is listed in the table below.

Jurisdiction	510 hectares of land for port-related development, 101,000 hectares of maritime jurisdiction and 81 kilometres of navigable channel.
Cargo	The majority of the port's trade throughput is containerised but it also handles breakbulk, liquid bulk, dry bulk, general cargoes and motor vehicles.
Trade	Total trade through the port in 2007-08 reached 75.7 million revenue tonnes. Of this total, containerised trade represented 70%; non-containerised general (breakbulk and motor vehicles) 19%; liquid bulk 7%; dry bulk 4%.
Economic contribution	The port contributes \$2.5 billion to the national economy annually.
Employment	The port's activities are directly linked to more than 13,700 jobs.
Trade Value	In 2007-08, the value of the port's trade was greater than \$90 billion. Nearly a quarter of the nation's international sea trade by value flows through the port.
Passengers	During 2007-08, 44 cruise ship visits were made bringing over 100,000 passengers and crew to Melbourne.
Vessel Movements	The port has over 7,000 vessel movements per year.
Facilities	Major assets and facilities include the shipping channels and 34 commercial berths located at five docks, river wharves, Gellibrand Pier (Williamstown) and Station Pier. These facilities include two modern, purpose built container terminals and specialised berths for motor vehicles, break bulk, dry bulk, liquid bulk and passengers.
Investment	In 2007-08, \$167.2 million was invested by PoMC on infrastructure projects in the port. This included \$118.7 million on the CDP and \$48.5 million on other projects.
Tenants	There are 35 major tenants in the port undertaking cargo handling and shipping related activities.
PoMC employees	To undertake its strategic management of the port, PoMC has 177 ongoing employees, 54 temporary employees and 15 contract employees (31 March 2009).

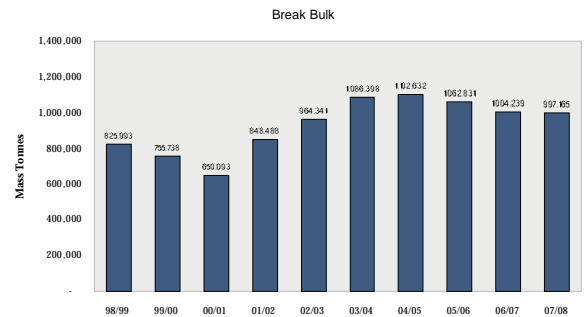
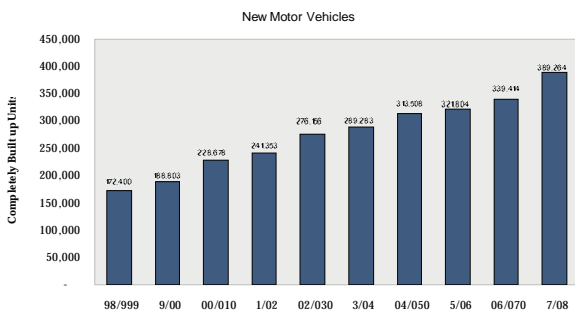
Trade statistics

The charts below present a 10 year profile of Port of Melbourne trade for each of the main cargo types handled at the port.



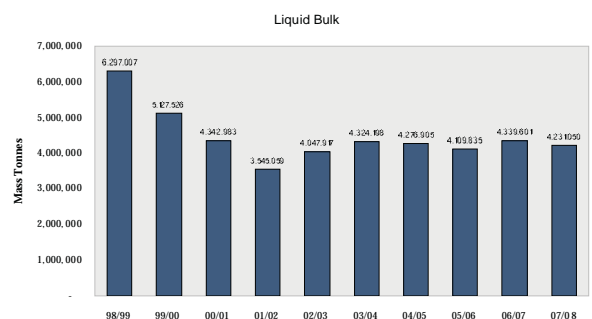
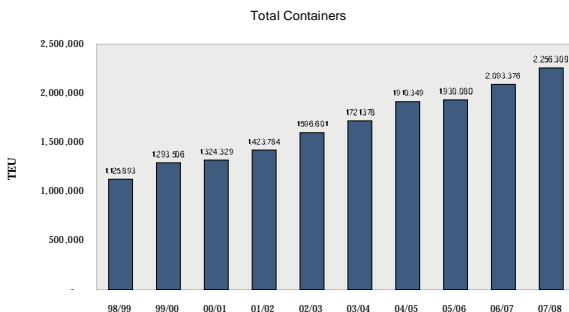
Total trade has increased consistently over the past 10 years, growing at an annual average rate of 4.7% per annum.

Total dry bulk trade increased substantially in 2001-02 due to the establishment of the ABA bulk grain facility at Appleton Dock. The drought has affected volumes in recent years.



Auto trade has more than doubled over the past 10 years with strong growth in exports to Middle East countries, and increased penetration of imported models into the local market.

Breakbulk trade has declined slightly in recent years as some cargoes have moved to the containerised mode of shipment.



Containerised trade, which currently accounts for over 68% (by mass tonnes) of total trade, continued to expand with annual TEU growth of 8.0% per annum over the past 10 years.

Liquid bulk trade has remained relatively static over the last 10 years, with the exception of a peak in 1998-99 due to a disruption in the pipeline supply from Longford Gippsland.

PORT OF MELBOURNE

Trade Catchment

The Port of Melbourne's trade catchment area includes four states – Victoria, Tasmania and parts of South Australia and New South Wales, positioning Port of Melbourne as a trade hub for south-eastern Australia (Figure 1).

Recognising the importance of the regional trade catchment areas, PoMC has trade facilitation managers based in South Australia, New South Wales and Tasmania.

Melbourne is the major mainland port for Tasmania's trade and provides sea links to both domestic and international markets.

Road and rail links connect the port to South Australia, regional New South Wales and the east coast of the Australian mainland, where the majority of Australia's population lives.

The volume and variety of cargo transported to and from the port is a major freight and logistics task. While the majority of the port's trade is generated from the Melbourne area, the port's connections with regional areas provide essential links to international markets for them.

TERMINAL OPERATORS

Overview

Port of Melbourne has 34 commercial berths at five docks, river wharves, Gellibrand Pier (Williamstown) and Station Pier (Port Melbourne).

Berth services include two modern, purpose-built international container terminals and multi-purpose berths that handle cargoes ranging from grain, cement and gypsum to motor vehicles and agricultural machinery. Specialised berths for dry cargoes include cement, grain, sugar, fly ash and gypsum, plus dedicated facilities for a variety of liquids, from molasses to crude oil and petrochemicals.

The berths at Station Pier service the Bass Strait passenger ferry, cruise shipping and visiting naval vessels. Managed and maintained by PoMC, the Port of Melbourne shipping channels provide safe and efficient access to the port.

PATRICK CONTAINER PORTS - SWANSON DOCK EAST

Patrick Container Ports (Patrick) handles containerised cargo at Swanson Dock East. Patrick operates Swanson Dock East 24-hours a day seven days a week. Receiving and delivery of containers is normally available six days per week, 24-hours a day. Coverage outside these hours is by arrangement.

Swanson Dock East operates a fully computerised terminal control system incorporating Navis Ship and Yard Planning, Equipment Control, Differential Global Positioning and a Paperless Gate. All services are available to ships berthing at Swanson Dock East including bunkers via barge, fresh water from the wharf and alongside ship repairs and surveying.

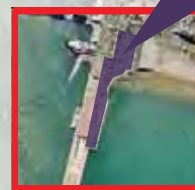

Port security

Port of Melbourne is a security regulated port under the *Maritime Transport & Offshore Facilities Security Act 2003* (Cwlth) (MTOFSA) complies with all requirements within its Maritime Security Plan, regulated by the Commonwealth Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government (DITRDG), Office of Transport Security.

As the port operator, PoMC's security responsibilities are to ensure the protection of the port's critical economic infrastructure, including shipping channels within port waters, and to mitigate any security risk to commercial shipping within our waters or while alongside at any of our facilities.

This is achieved through a well practised regime of extensive security monitoring, patrolling and reporting through our security provider ISS Security and well established close working relationships with Victorian and Commonwealth law enforcement agencies. A port security committee, in collaboration with port stakeholders, addresses key issues.

Operators or other stakeholders in the Port of Melbourne as well as operators of Australian or foreign registered ships who are unsure of their obligations under the Maritime Transport Security Act should seek advice from DITRDG.

The plan has been produced by PoMC and is integrated with the state and local (municipal) emergency management arrangements. The plan, which ensures the response to an emergency within the port, is a cooperative one and conducted with a coordinated approach from the port community and outside agencies.

All emergencies must be reported immediately to Melbourne VTS where the plan may be activated when necessary.

Pilotage

Port Phillip Sea Pilots

Pilotage is compulsory for all vessels over 35 metres Length Over All (LOA) bound for, or leaving from berths in the Port of Melbourne, except for coastal vessels whose Master holds a current Exemption Certificate.

Pilotage services at the Port of Melbourne are provided by Port Phillip Sea Pilots Pty Ltd, 24 hours a day, every day of the year.

Pilots require 24 hours' notice of arrival at the Pilot Boarding Ground and a minimum of three hours' notice for departures or removals for ships at Melbourne anchorages.
