Footscray Wharf Redevelopment

Temporary realignment of part of Maribyrnong River Trail shared use path, Footscray

To progress works at Footscray Wharf, Port of Melbourne Corporation (PoMC) will realign a short section of the Maribyrnong River Trail shared use path south of Shepherd Bridge, Footscray.

The realignment will safely divert pedestrians and cyclists around construction works at Footscray Wharf. The realigned section of path will be constructed of compacted crushed rock and marked by bollards and safety signs. The original path and grass verge will be reinstated on completion of Footscray Wharf works.

Timing

The temporary realignment is expected to remain in place until the completion of the Footscray Wharf Redevelopment project in late 2011.

Expected impacts

The new section of path will be constructed prior to closing the existing path, so no disruption to access is expected. Safety personnel will be in place whilst the diversion is made.

We appreciate your patience during the works, which will enable PoMC to transform the site into a useable commercial mooring facility with public access to the riverfront.
