




Market Site Demolition Project

Port of Melbourne's development of Market Site, includes an expansion of 29-hectares with the potential to improve heavy vehicle access into and throughout the port. In addition, the site will deliver purpose-built facilities, including new warehousing capacity, empty container storage and an Urban Freight Consolidation Centre. These initiatives reflect Port of Melbourne's and the Victorian Government's commitment to economic prosperity and productivity.



Port of Melbourne will be commencing works at Market Site in 2026.

When will the works take place?

Works will take place from Wednesday 11 February in the north-west corner of the Market Site. Works will be completed in stages, progressing from the west end of the site to the east.

Contractors will be on site **Monday to Friday 7:00am to 7:00pm, and Saturdays 7:00am to 3:00pm**. These works will continue through to mid-late 2026, weather permitting.

Works generally will not be carried out on Sundays and Public Holidays. In some instances, works may need to be delivered outside of these hours. Information about changes to working hours will be updated on the [Port of Melbourne website](#).

What to expect

This site will be accessed by passenger and heavy vehicles via the main entry at Footscray Road to the east of Dock Link Road.

Hoarding will be installed around the perimeter of Market Site as works progress. This means the site will be fully contained and will not be publicly accessible or affect any public roads or cycle paths.

Frequently asked questions	
What to expect	The initial phase of the project involves staged demolition and site clearance works within the Market Site precinct, including controlled demolition and removal of materials, waste segregation and making the site safe for subsequent redevelopment.
When will the works take place?	<p>Works will be undertaken from Monday to Friday 7:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturdays 7:00am to 3:00pm.</p> <p>Any works outside of these hours, including Sundays or Public Holidays will be communicated in advance of works, when impacts may be minor but unavoidable.</p> <p>Demolition works are expected to be complete mid to late 2026. Civil works will commence following demolition and will continue through to 2027-28.</p> <p>The works will be undertaken in stages, beginning at the north-west end of the site.</p>
Environment	<p>Demolition works will be undertaken in line with the project's Environmental Management Plan, which includes but is not limited to noise, air quality, water quality and waste management.</p> <p>Environmental condition assessments will occur throughout the works program, to support compliance with environmental laws and duties.</p>
Noise and air quality	Our contractor <i>Symal</i> will ensure project activities are carried out in accordance with relevant guidelines and requirements.
Materials and waste	A Symal Waste Management Plan has been developed in accordance with WorkSafe and EPA Victoria requirements.
Traffic	<p>This site will be accessed by authorised passenger and heavy vehicles via the main entry at Footscray Road to the east of Dock Link Road.</p> <p>Heavy Vehicles will comply with "no truck zones" and other road changes implemented as part of the West Gate Tunnel project, to help keep heavy vehicles off residential streets.</p>
