

Unlocking Victoria's Future

Developing the Fourth International Container Terminal

The Webb Dock North Container Terminal is targeted for 2036 and would be a milestone in the history of Port of Melbourne.

The project would also secure the long-term future for the Tasmanian trades at Victoria Dock.

Driving economic growth and keeping goods moving, the container terminal is projected to support 6,700 jobs during construction and operation, and would result in a boost of approximately \$5 billion to the Victorian economy.
