

February 2023 container volumes decrease on the prior year

2023 were down 18.4% over February 2022 with a total 2022, with hay & fodder, pulp & wastepaper, and dried of 219,606 TEU. Year to date container volumes are consistent with prior year.

Total container throughput (full & empty) for February **Full overseas exports** were down 4.4% on February milk all below last year's levels.

Full overseas imports were down 28.9% on February 2022 with miscellaneous manufactures, furniture, metal February 2022. manufactures, domestic appliances, textiles, and paperboard, all below last year's levels.
