Governments confirm Port of Melbourne's critical role

The port of Melbourne continues to operate as usual providing much needed goods and supplies to the nation at this challenging time.

As a vital link in Australia's supply chain, Port of Melbourne supports the reassurance given by the Federal and State infrastructure and transport ministers through the Transport and Infrastructure Council that maintaining freight movements is a high priority for all governments.

The <u>communique</u> from the Transport and Infrastructure Council reaffirms the critical role of the freight sector in providing essential supplies and recognises the importance of all members of the freight distribution chain, including ports.
