

Changes to Coode Road

As part of the Port Rail Transformation Project (PRTP) located in the Swanson Dock precinct, the Port of Melbourne will be permanently closing a section of Coode Road between Dock Link Road and Phillipps Road. With major works for the project already well underway, this is the next stage of development for the new PRTP rail terminal.

Connectivity will still be maintained between Dock Link Road and Coode Road, through the development of a new two-lane, two-way road, named Intermodal Way.

There will be a two-phased implementation of these permanent changes to Coode Road.

Phase One

Temporary Diversion

From July 2022, there will be temporary diversion of this section of Coode Road. Please observe traffic management and signage which will be in place during this period.






Phase Two

Permanent Switch

Scheduled for March 2023, there will be a permanent switch to a new road called Intermodal Way.
