



Works Notice: Webb Dock East Extension Project

WORKS TAKING PLACE

This notice is to advise you of works taking place at Webb Dock East, which will remove a redundant section of concrete and extend the quay line by 71 metres. This will restore Webb Dock East's intended design capacity to a two-berth terminal.

- The works will generally take place Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm, and Saturdays 7am to 1pm, subject to weather conditions.
- You may notice intermittent construction and machinery noise.
- There may be some 24/7 works, but they are not expected to be disruptive.
