



## Works Notice: Webb Trail Revetment Remediation

**In June 2021 the Webb Trail received significant storm damage with erosion issues to the east and complete failure of the primary armour layer in selected areas in the south. The south side is currently closed due to safety concerns to the public.**

The Webb Dock Revetment Project will remediate the storm damaged sections of rock revetment and the pavement promenade, and associated sundry works.

### WORKS TAKING PLACE

This notice is to advise you of works taking place on the Webb Trail. The project will require closing the southern part of Webb Trail to the public while the works are undertaken. Construction access will be through the Victorian International Container Terminal (VICT).

**The majority of the trail remains open to the public.**

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- The works will commence in June and are scheduled to be completed September–October 2022.
- You may notice intermittent construction and machinery noise.
- Some areas of the trail will not be accessible for fishing.
- Access to the observation platform will remain open.
- We ask all members of the community to observe signage and to not enter the construction area.
