

Here's a strange thing: a lot of people don't even realise that we have a huge port right here near the centre of Melbourne.






# Did you know?





- The Port of Melbourne is the largest container and general cargo port in Australia
- The biggest container ship to call at the port was around 280 metres long - over 100 metres longer than the field at the MCG
- Over 50 cruise ships visit Station Pier each season



- The port has been operating for around 150 years
- Parts of the main shipping channel on the Yarra River are man-made
- A standard container is 20 feet long (6 metres) and can fit 10,000 playstations






# Did you know?

**Every day of the year the port handles:**

- Over 6500 containers
- Almost 1000 motor vehicles
- Around 3200 tonnes of fruit, vegetables and nuts
- Around 2300 tonnes of dairy products
- 550 tonnes of tea and coffee
- 2500 tonnes of wood and timber
- 5100 tonnes of cereals




(1)Red (2)Brown (3)Orange (4)Green (5)Purple (6)Blue (7)Dark Blue (8)White


(1)Light Blue (2)Dark Blue (3)Orange (4)Grey (5)Dark Grey (6)Yellow (7)Brown (8)Black


