On behalf of the vessel master, I hereby accept to undertake the works in accordance with the conditions below. I agree that it is my responsibility to provide the vessel master with a copy of this permit and the standard conditions, before undertaking this activity.

1. No activities are to be undertaken below the load line.
2. The vessel master is responsible for fulfilling all Occupational Health and Safety requirements associated with works on the vessel (e.g. working from heights).
3. All products, including cleaning detergents, rust and paint particles, must be contained and collected on deck, barge or wharf using adequate collection bins. No solid waste, waste water or paint shall enter the waterway.
4. All waste collected shall be deemed quarantine waste and disposed of via a qualified Contractor and in accordance with EPA Victoria or Quarantine regulations. Approved Contractors are listed in the *Port Information Guide* and IMOs [GISIS](#).
5. Only products approved under Australian and Victorian legislation may be used. Anti-fouling paints used must be in accordance with the International Maritime Organisation Convention and the *Protection of the Sea (Harmful Anti-fouling Systems) Act 2006* (Cwlth).
6. In the event of a spill, Melbourne VTS must be informed (via telephone +61 3 9644 9700) and adequate action taken to contain the spill.
7. Port of Melbourne has the right to audit activities, and if required alter or stop works.

Contact Melbourne VTS by telephone +61 3 9644 9700 prior to commencing and ending approved works. Additional requirements may be placed on the vessel.
