Expanding Melbourne's Port Capacity

As part of the \$1.6 billion project to expand capacity at the Port of Melbourne, construction work at Webb Dock is to be undertaken in three separate 'packages' - site preparation, roads and services and maritime works.

Port of Melbourne Corporation will provide the necessary marine and civil 'backbone' infrastructure, while the successful bidders will be responsible for the development of their terminal facilities.

The works packages will be progressively staged enabling the 'business of the port' to continue at Webb Dock. Project staff will endeavour to minimise impacts on port operations and surrounding neighbours.

The three works packages are:

Site preparation and earthworks, consisting mainly of earthworks and compacting the ground in the area north of Williamstown Rd

Roads and services works, encompassing new road connections to the M1 West Gate Freeway, interface buffers such as noise walls and landscaping

Maritime works, incorporating dock deepening, wharf construction and bank protection works

All construction works are governed by a rigorous Environmental Management Plan, which is a not-negotiable 'rule book' that sets out the environmental protection requirements and various monitoring regimes. In addition, the Environmental Management Plan also carries obligations in respect of dust and noise management. The entire Plan document can be downloaded from the Project website.

To stay informed about the various work packages, real time works information is available on the Project's website. Compatible with most mobile devices, the information is updated daily.


