



Webb Dock Works Advisory Notice



Key Works at Webb Dock

MONDAY 19 SEPTEMBER TO SUNDAY 2 OCTOBER 2016

Road and other service works

Improvement works to Webb Dock Drive (formerly Williamstown Rd) and Empress Rd are ongoing. Webb Dock Drive, west of Empress Rd is currently one way for westbound traffic only. Concrete barriers protect the work sites on each side of this section of Webb Dock Drive. Vehicles exiting Toll Logistics and Toll Shipping sites via the Webb Dock Drive gates need to turn left and exit via the TALA site from where they will be able to turn right into Kooringa Way and leave the Webb Dock precinct. Out of hours works, compliant with EPA noise guidelines, are scheduled to take place on weekends between 1pm Saturday to 7am Monday.

Empress Rd will be closed (subject to weather) on the weekend of 24/25 September for concrete island and signage works between the hours of 1pm Saturday and 5am Monday. The southern end of Empress Rd has reconfigured line marking and signage, including a change in give way priority - please comply with speed limits (40km/h on Empress Rd) and give way signs.

CitiPower is currently working in Webb Dock Drive and within Toll Tasmania. Their works include a power shutdown for parts of Webb Dock on Sunday 25 September, and are anticipated to be completed on 29 September. Traffic control measures are in place on Webb Dock Drive, north bound, under the West Gate Bridge during pedestrian path works. These works are anticipated to be completed by late October.

Maritime Construction

Wharf construction activities are progressing well at Webb Dock West. Project dredging works are complete. Wharf rehabilitation works continue at Webb Dock East. Out of hours works compliant with EPA noise guidelines are taking place each night between 6pm and 7am and on Sundays between 7am and 6pm.

Terminal works

Out of hours works, compliant with EPA noise guidelines are scheduled each Saturday and Sunday from 7am to 6pm for pavement, wharf and terminal works and Monday to Sunday 6pm to 7am for wharf works and line marking.

Maritime Cove

The south western end of Webb Trail, west of the observation platform, is temporarily closed to enable path resurfacing works as well as installation of a new seat and bin. Access to the observation platform will not be impacted. Works at the new *Playscape* play area continue. Site stripping and preparation will commence this week and will continue for the next 3 weeks. The relocated exercise equipment area is expected to be re-opened to the public by the end of September. Alternative access to the existing boardwalks and Webb Trail may be in place from time to time to enable works to be undertaken safely.

Information Line

Please note the project information line is now operating during normal business hours only, i.e. Mon to Fri 8:30am to 5:30pm. This reflects the completion of the majority of works that may have an impact on residents, businesses and drivers. Project information line: 1800 451 056.
