



Webb Dock Works **Advisory Notice**

SATURDAY 22 OCTOBER & SUNDAY 23 OCTOBER 2016

BMD Constructions will be conducting road maintenance works on a section of Webb Dock Drive (formerly Williamstown Rd) on the Port side of the noise wall - subject to weather.

Following the formation of a few minor pot holes in an area between the Todd Rd gate and Empress Rd, a layer of asphalt was removed on Sunday 25 September, and in follow-up to these emergency works, asphalt completion works are now required to pave the road surface.

The asphaltting will occur on Saturday 22 October from 1pm to 5pm and on Sunday 23 October from 8am to 3pm. We ask that you observe warning signs if you travel in this area. The works were initially to be conducted on the weekend of 15-16 October however were postponed due to rain.

The contractor has indicated that as these works are occurring behind the noise wall, they anticipate low to medium noise levels, although they may be noticeable to some neighbouring homes.

Live noise monitoring will take place during the works period and the contractor's supervisors will use this data to manage the activities.

Traffic management will see traffic diversions put in place during these works, with vehicles leaving the southern part of the port (i.e. from Empress Road and Webb Dock Drive) being diverted via the TALA car park and Kooringa Way.
