



Key Works at Webb Dock

MONDAY 31 OCTOBER TO SUNDAY 13 NOVEMBER 2016

Road and other service works

Improvement works to Webb Dock Drive (formerly Williamstown Rd) and Empress Road are ongoing. Webb Dock Drive, west of Empress Road is currently one way for westbound traffic only. Concrete barriers protect the work site on the north side of this section of Webb Dock Drive. Vehicles exiting Toll Logistics and Toll Shipping sites via the Webb Dock Drive gates need to turn left and exit via the TALA site from where they will be able to turn right into Kooronga Way and leave the Webb Dock precinct.

Out of hours works, compliant with EPA noise guidelines, are scheduled to take place on weekends from 1pm Saturday to 7am Monday. Traffic control measures are in place on Webb Dock Drive, north bound, under the West Gate Bridge during pedestrian path works, due for completion in early November.

Wearing course and line marking will be replaced on a section of Webb Dock Drive (east of Empress Road) from 1pm Saturday 5 November to 5pm Sunday 6 November, subject to weather. Low to medium noise levels are anticipated as the works are occurring behind the noise wall. Noise monitoring and traffic management will be in place during the works. If unsuitable weather is forecast, the works will be postponed to the next weekend.

Maritime Construction

Wharf construction is progressing at Webb Dock West. Wharf rehabilitation continues at Webb Dock East. Weekend works at Webb Dock East and West to occur between 1-5pm Saturday and 7am-5pm Sunday. Daily early start works between 6am and 7am at Webb Dock East.

Shared pathway

A remaining section of pathway for pedestrians and cyclists is due for completion in November. This will create a continuous pathway from the Yarra River near the West Gate Bridge, through Westgate Park, along Todd Rd and join up with Perce White Reserve and the Webb Dock Trail to the observation platform. A landscaped path alongside Todd Rd features drinking fountains and seating among mature and low rise plants.



Maritime Cove

Resurfacing works are almost complete to the south western end of Webb Trail, beyond the observation platform. This area will reopen once the works are complete. Works continue at the new *Playscape* park and playground area. Alternative access to boardwalks and Webb Trail may be in place from time-to-time to enable works.
