Key Works at Webb Dock

MONDAY 12 DECEMBER 2016 TO SUNDAY 15 JANUARY 2017

Community park

Construction continues on the new community park and playground on the foreshore at Perc White Reserve. Installation is well underway on the park's centrepiece attractions - a giant life-saving tower and salvaged port equipment including buoys, a crows nest and channel markers. Alternative access to boardwalks may be in place to enable works. Opening of the playground is scheduled for early 2017. A pre-summer inspection and maintenance of the boardwalks is being undertaken.



Road and other service works

Improvement works to Webb Dock Drive, formerly Williamstown Rd, and Empress Road are nearing completion.

Webb Dock Drive, west of Empress Road, will remain one way for west bound traffic until all asphalt work and verge treatments are complete. Traffic bollards now define the work sites on both sides of this section of Webb Dock Drive. Out-of-hours works, compliant with EPA noise guidelines, are scheduled to take place during mid-week nightshifts and on weekends from 1pm Saturday to 7am Monday. The works are necessary to avoid impact to Port operations.

The Westgate Park path is now open for use by pedestrians and cyclists. A continuous path extends from the Yarra River through Westgate Park under the West Gate Bridge and along Todd Road to join up with the new community park (under construction) and observation platform at Sandridge Beach.

Maritime Construction

Wharf construction is completed at Webb Dock West. Wharf rehabilitation continues at Webb Dock East. Out-of-hours works compliant with EPA noise guidelines may occur between 1pm-5pm Saturdays, 7am-5pm Sundays, and weekdays between 6am-7am.
